The Z Tourney Rules Sheet

Welcome to the 10th annual Z Tourney. This is a memorial tournament where family and friends of Dan Zurawski come together to celebrate Dan's life. Proceeds from this event will fund a SCHOLARSHIP or a Charitable Giving Fund in honor of Dan.

The following will discuss the rules of the tournament; please direct any questions to Jason Brazzale (<u>jdbrazzale@gmail.com</u>)

Tournament format/rules

- **1.** The Z Tournament is a **live release paper tournament**...this means you need to measure all fish caught and document the catch with a digital camera on the boat right after catching the fish.
 - a. **Things to include in picture.** Fish and measuring device (provided) with visible length markings.
 - b. **Picture taking.** Put fish on measuring devise directly below visible length markings with mouth closed on the end of the measuring devise. Pinch tail and snap photo. We will utilize the camera's zoom feature!
 - c. **Don't have a digital camera?** You may bring in your catch to be measured at the conclusion of the tournament. **Fish that mysteriously "shrink" will be recorded as their length shows after tournament...illegal fish will disqualify you from the tournament!**
 - d. **Keeping fish**. You are encouraged to take legal fish home with you if you desire a meal or two or five. Kept fish must be of legal size and daily bag/possession limits must be followed. We will measure the kept fish at Lakeside Bar after the conclusion of the tournament.
 - e. **Fish care.** Please eliminate undue stress on these fish. The Stevens Point Flowage is a very nice fishery; let's preserve this resource.
 - f. Please observe all WI DNR fishing and boating regulations!
 - g. Z Tourney participants agree to be responsible for their conduct, equipment and accept all liability. It is strongly encouraged that all participants wear life jackets.

Tournament times

- 1. Registration
 - a. Registration runs from 6:00AM—9:00AM at Lakeside Bar; once registered, you are free to launch boat and start fishing.
 - b. You may use any other boat launch on the STPT Flowage.
- 2. Ending
 - a. The Z Tourney ends at 2:00PM with fish registration directly after at Lakeside Bar.
- 3. All anglers with fish submissions need to be in the registration line by 2:45PM.

Tournament fees

- 1. Individual: \$30
- **2.** Boat of three or more: \$75

- 3. Boats getting \$100 or more in donations will have their entry fee waived and are automatically entered into the Big Fish Pot.
- 4. \$5 OPTIONAL Big Fish Pot

Prize categories

- 1. Individual qualifying species
 - a. Bluegill
 - b. Crappie
 - c. Smallmouth bass
 - d. Largemouth bass
 - e. Walleye

- f. Northern Pike
- h. Musky
- i. Bowfishing
- j. "Other" (any fish species not listed above)

2. Team category

- a. Total length: Add the longest (1) fish of each individual qualifying species to sum your total overall length.
- 3. Big fish (optional)
 - b. Longest fish of the day will take the optional pot.
