After I graduated from high school, I started my coaching career at Pacelli as an assistant in baseball and football while going to college. When I graduated from college, I taught and coached at a couple of other schools before I found my way back to where it all started - Pacelli Athletics - as I became the Athletic Director in the fall of 2005, a position I've held for the past 16 years.

During all those years, I have witnessed and been a part of many successes and a few challenges in Pacelli Athletics. But more important than the successes and challenges, I have been lucky to work with so many incredible athletes and coaches. I have seen these young students grow and mature into not only good athletes but quality people who have gone on to be successful in society. I like to think that athletics at Pacelli played a part in developing and preparing these athletes for life after graduation.

As the years go by since I walked the halls of Pacelli as a student, I am reminded that our athletic facilities are also growing older and are in need of repair and updating, especially here at Pacelli Catholic High School. We have a number of athletic funding needs to help continue the successful athletic tradition at Pacelli.

Our funding priorities are:

- Refinishing the PCHS gym floor
- Enhancing softball practice field and adding baseball practice field at PCHS
- Gym entrance landscaping and signage updates
- Locker room refresh and bench resurfacing
- Gym roof replacement and interior block work
- New updated sideline chairs and scoring table
- LED lighting in the gym

These projects come with a total price tag of around \$250,000+, depending on the scope and scale of the landscaping, signage, and locker room projects and fall outside of the annual athletics budget. **That's why we need your help.**

We are moving forward with plans to refinish the gym floor this summer to get it ready for the rapidly approaching volleyball season. We hope to get the softball and baseball practice fields fixed up this fall to have them ready for our teams come the spring season, and we need at least \$75,000 for these projects alone.

He worked hard to afford us the opportunities we were given and could always be seen in the bleachers or the sidelines cheering us on at our our football, basketball, and baseball games. Decades after we all graduated, my dad was proud to continue his tradition of supporting Pacelli Athletics and almost never missed an athletic competition of his grandkids.
