

presents Gregg Hansel with a


"People are often unreasonable, irrational, and self-centered. Forgive them anyway. If you are kind, people may accuse you of selfish, ulterior motives. Be kind anyway."

"If you are honest and sincere, people may deceive you. Be honest and sincere anyway."

"The good you do today will often be forgotten. Do good anyway."

So much of what we try to do with students is in sync with that poem. We try to help our students be forgiving, even when it is tough, to be kind, even when it may take sacrifice, to do good things for the world, even though it may not help us personally. It is not always easy for students to do that, but together we have to continue that work. The final line of the poem sums it up. "In the final analysis, it is between you and God. It was never between you and them anyway."

The start of our school year has been wonderful. For the first time in many years, our enrollment from three year-old preschool through grade twelve has gone up. The increase isn't huge (up 14 students for a total of 780 students) but it is certainly movement in the right direction. We always have room for more, so keep spreading the word.
