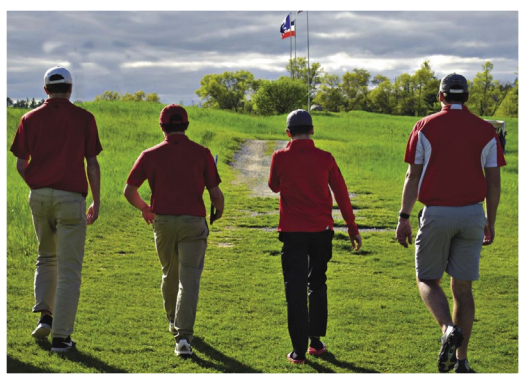

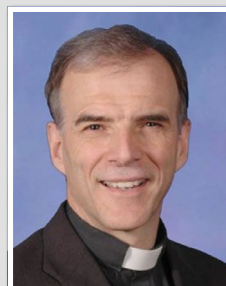

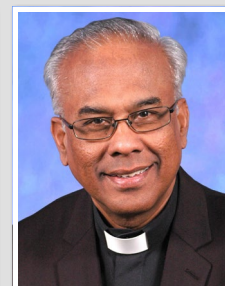

FROM THE DESK OF THE DEAN

Have you seen the movie "Yesterday?" It features a struggling musician named Jack who, after a dismal gig at a local festival, decides to hang up his guitar. But a mysterious global blackout hits while he's biking home. While biking he runs into an embankment and goes flying through the air and he's knocked unconscious in the chaos. He wakes up in a world with a few missing pieces, including his two front teeth. Pepsi exists, but not Coca-Cola. "Saturday Night Live" is now taped on Thursdays. And to Jack's increasing bafflement, nobody has heard of The Beatles. Seeing a golden opportunity, Jack reboots his career and claims The Beatles' music as his own. Soon, he's discovered by a local celebrity. Hailed as the greatest singer-songwriter of his generation, Jack prepares to release an album, but he's increasingly consumed by guilt over his deception as he claims The Beatles' music as his own. Yesterday's Beatles songs are imbued with a timeless, mystical power that turns Jack into a celebrity almost overnight. The movie is a light-hearted and romantic movie that features all the expected downsides of fame.

Now I want you to imagine (pun intended) that all the world mysteriously and unexpectedly forgot about the person of Jesus Christ. More than a famous band that revolutionized the world of music but the Man-God who more importantly saves the world. To further complicate matters, you are the only person who remembers the sayings of our Lord, the Commandments, the Beatitudes, His miracles, His Passion, Death and Resurrection. The more you are puzzled by the mysterious phenomenon of no one remembering Jesus, the more you share and the more you share, the more that the Word gets out and people are now flocking to hear you give witness of the forgotten life of this so called Savior. Pretty soon you have stadiums that are filled with people longing to hear more of what you are saying as you continue to describe this mysterious Savior named Jesus Christ.

I know that this may sound incredible but my point is that we somewhat already live in the imaginary world described above. How often do we take for granted the power

Our faith is designed to be shared, lived, and relied upon as the one and only hope our world has left. I pray that this coming year will be filled with a renewed excitement of rediscovering Jesus in your life that can only be measured with the excitement and vigor that we bring the Good News of our Savior to the world in which we live.

A MESSAGE FROM **MR. HANSEL**

I am beginning my 36th year with Pacelli Catholic Schools (PCS) and I was reflecting on how things are now compared to when I started. A lot of change happened during that time.

Our configuration of schools has drastically changed. In 1984, the parish elementary schools were all K-8 schools, there was no school at St. Bronislava, there was no Early Childhood Center or preschool program, and there was no middle school (not until 1987). Over the past thirty years, Pacelli Catholic Schools have been reconfigured a number of times to better serve the students and to provide for more efficiencies. In 1984, each parish was totally responsible for the costs of their own school, which was very expensive. Today, the parish portion of the Catholic schools budget is less than 25%.

In 1984, the communication tool of choice was a typewriter. There were no computers in the schools. Our first foray into technology was to share a "computer bus" with the public schools. An old school bus was repurposed into a mini classroom with 16 Atari computers. We would get the bus for half a day every two weeks, and if you could safely get it plugged in (and the computers worked), children could play one of two games. Today, we have one of the most advanced technology programs in the state of Wisconsin. Thanks to the generosity of many businesses and individuals, we are able to provide students with a wide variety of opportunities. Computer coding and STEM courses are taught in every grade, beginning in kindergarten. Middle school students work on robotics and high school students can take Project Lead the Way courses in computers, engineering, or medical fields or tap into their creative, entrepreneurial side by taking courses linked to our IDEA (Innovate, Design, Explore, Apply) Lab.

The amount of service that students do each year has grown tremendously. Beginning in kindergarten, all children are involved with giving back to their community, with some students performing hundreds of hours. Teaching methods have changed so that each child has a more individualized educational plan that is tailored to their strengths and needs.

Many of the traditions of a Catholic school, however, have not changed. Students are still instructed in their Catholic faith, not just with knowledge but in attitudes and practices as well. An emphasis on the Eucharist and the sacramental life is still the focus of school life. While we don't have any religious sisters in our school today, we do have dedicated, faith-filled faculty and staff who are very highly trained. In fact, teachers from Pacelli Catholic Schools have earned more than 20 Herb Kohl Educational Foundation Teacher Fellowship Awards, one of the highest, if not the highest number in the entire state.

Academically, PCS continues to provide a very rigorous curriculum, with the result being some of the highest test scores you will find in the area. The four major national awards that our schools have earned is a testament to that. Our students go on to excel in college and in life after college, becoming the future leaders and parishioners in their communities.

So, even though some things have changed, the important parts are still ensuring that our students get the tools to move forward in life successfully. None of this, however, would be possible without your help. Your gifts of time, treasure, talent, and prayers make all the difference. Thank you! We wouldn't be able to do all that we do without you.

Please remember to keep us in your prayers. Know that we will pray for you as well.

SISTER JANE EPPING AWARDS CEREMONY

The Sister Jane Epping Awards Ceremony was held on Friday, May 24th in the Faith, Arts, and Community Center. The awards ceremony was named after Sister Jane Epping, a School Sister of Notre Dame, who died from cancer while serving Pacelli as teacher and Dean of Students. She exemplified Christian love and generosity, intellectual curiosity, and academic excellence. Awards for students that demonstrate these same values were presented in the Student of the Year Awards, along with several community awards and scholarships. Nearly \$36,000 in scholarships was presented to continuing PCS students, and over \$12,000 in PCS scholarship funds was awarded to our graduating seniors, not including the thousands of dollars awarded from various colleges, universities, local businesses, and community organizations.

The senior class was recognized for their achievements including the President's Award for Academic Excellence, and those who earned a GPA of 4.0 or higher. Madeline Hinaus was announced as class valedictorian and both Karah Kluck and Autumn Trzebiatowski shared the honor of class salutatorian.

Welcome Olivia as the latest Cardinal to join our Pacelli alumni family!

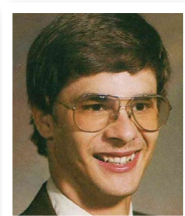

A TALE OF TWO PILGRIMAGES:

BR. JAMES MILLER'S JOURNEY TO BEATIFICATION

It all started in Custer, WI in September 1944 where Br. James Miller was born and raised on the family farm until the former Pacelli High School student went on to become a Christian Brother.

He spent three years at Cretin High School in Saint Paul, MN teaching Spanish, English, and religion, supervising school maintenance, and coaching football before making his perpetual vows in August 1960. From there he was called to serve in Nicaragua until his religious superiors ordered him to leave in July 1979 during the time of the Sandinista revolution for fear that he might be at risk as he worked for the Somoza government. So he returned to Cretin High School in the fall of 1979 and then participated in the Sangre de Cristo renewal program in New Mexico in 1980.

But his mission work was his true calling and he was sent to serve in Guatemala in January 1981, teaching at the secondary school in Huehuetenango and worked at the Indian Center where young, indigenous Mayans from rural areas studied and trained in agriculture. In the afternoon of February 13, 1982, he was shot several times by three hooded men and died instantly. Br. James Miller was martyred at the age of 37. After funeral rites in Guatemala and Saint Paul, MN, he was buried in the parish cemetery in Polonia, WI.

On November 8, 2018 Pope Francis approved a decree recognizing that Br. James Miller died as a martyr meaning a celebration of his beatification can now occur. Then on April 17, 2019, the Congregation of the Causes of Saints announced the official date of the Beatification of Br. James Miller to occur on December 7, 2019 in Huehuetenango, Guatemala.



THE BEATIFICATION OF BR. JAMES MILLER WILL OCCUR ON DECEMBER 7, 2019.

To commemorate the first De La Salle Christian Brother from the United States to be beatified, the Lasallian Volunteers (LVs) in collaboration with the Midwest District and Pacelli Catholic Schools, hosted a pilgrimage on May 29 from Pacelli High School to Polonia, WI, where Br. James is buried. A prayer service was held at Pacelli High School before the pilgrimage kicked off in which packets of wildflower seeds were distributed to symbolize the roots of his life and spiritual calling here in Central Wisconsin. A total of 50 walkers made the nearly 10 mile trek, with about another 40 guests awaiting their arrival at the gravesite of Br. James. Among those walkers was Br. Paul, who was the roommate of Br. James at the time of his martyrdom in Guatemala. Br. Paul completed the journey carrying with him a photo of his late roommate to further honor his memory.

A second pilgrimage of even greater distance will be occurring December 4-9, 2019 - a pilgrimage to Guatemala for the Beatification Mass of Blessed Brother James Miller, FSC. Organized by Fr. Tom Linder, former dean of the Stevens Point Deanery and current pastor of St. Anne Parish in Wausau, the pilgrimage will take participants on the spiritual journey of Br. James with daily Mass and excursions throughout the Guatemalan countryside, culminating with the beatification celebration on December 7. Interested in joining the pilgrimage? 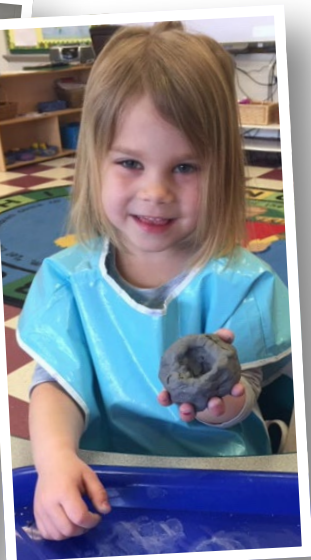

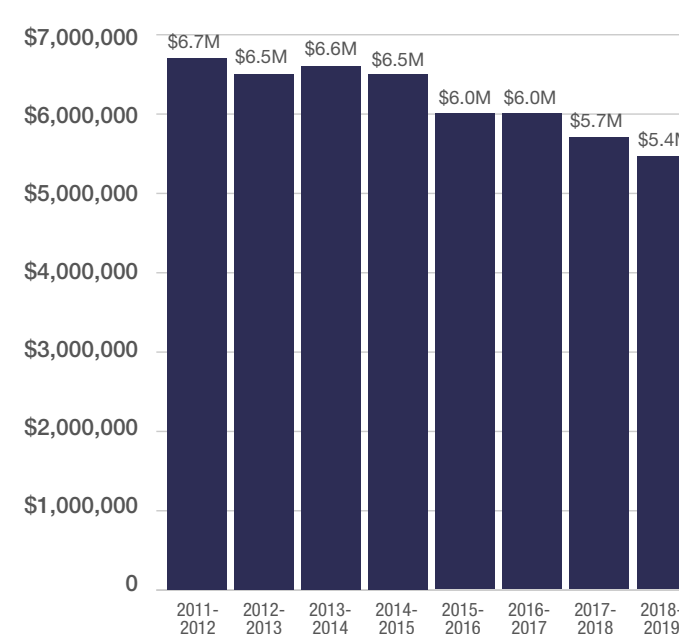

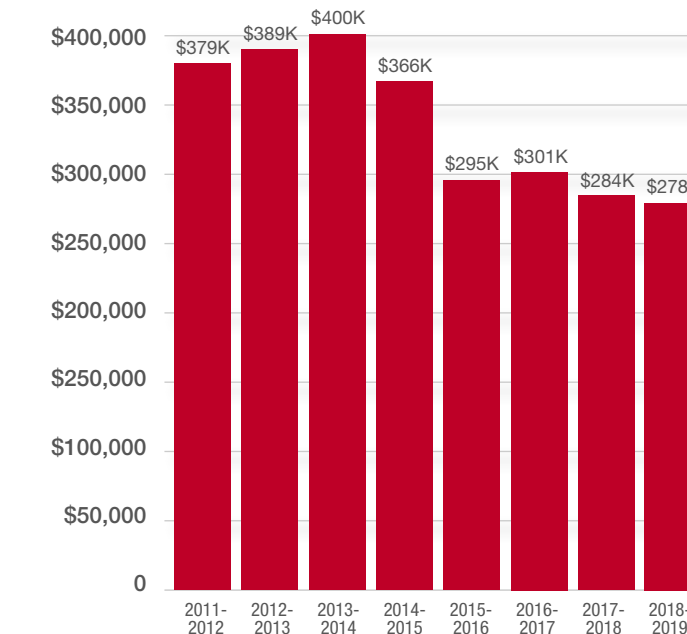
