

At a recent meeting of the Pacelli Catholic Schools Education Commission, we spent time reviewing the faith and service aspects of our schools and what more we can do. They also expressed how forward thinking our teaching methods are, the quality of the education, and some of the special activities we do, including computer coding, STEM education, the IDEA Lab and TAB Studio at Pacelli, and more. They even suggested that we take our best practices on the road sharing our teaching methods with other educators at professional development conferences. We will share more when we have the complete report.

On behalf of the staff and students in Pacelli, we hope you have a fruitful and blessed Easter. We will keep you all in our prayers — please do the same for us.
