Those are the words we proclaim at Easter time, celebrating the great news of the Resurrection. Our Lenten season in Pacelli Catholic Schools was full of wonderful prayer, activities, service, and sacraments. Now is our time to continue that faith in celebration throughout the entire 50 days of Easter. I hope you can celebrate that with us as well.

As a Catholic school system, we often reflect on the efforts we make to insure that we are sharing the Catholic faith in its fullness. While this

year's Catholic Schools Week activities were stymied due to snow and extreme cold temperatures leading to four consecutive days off of school, we continue to reflect on ways we can spread joy and share our faith. At a recent meeting of the Pacelli Catholic Schools Education Commission, we spent time reviewing the faith and service aspects of our schools and what more we can do. Prayer, community service, and sacramental celebrations are all part of the weekly fabric in our schools. Beyond daily religion classes, our students have many opportunities to share and express their faith. A special event, celebrating the life and pending beatification of Brother James Miller, a former Pacelli student, is highlighted later in this newsletter. All of you are welcome to join us that week.

In February, a team of five educators from around the country spent four days in Stevens Point evaluating our schools as part of our regular accreditation process. The team interviewed numerous groups of students, parents, staff, and community members and spent time evaluating almost every teacher. We will not get the formal report until late May, but we were told by the team that their recommendation is to accredit the school system with no reservations. They also expressed how forward thinking our teaching methods are, the quality of the education, and some of the special activities we do, including computer coding, STEM education, the IDEA Lab and TAB Studio at Pacelli, and more. They even suggested that we take our best practices on the road sharing our teaching methods with other educators at professional development conferences. We will share more when we have the complete report.

On behalf of the staff and students in Pacelli, we hope you have a fruitful and blessed Easter. We will keep you all in our prayers — please do the same for us.
