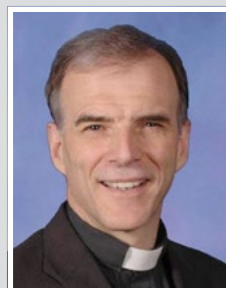

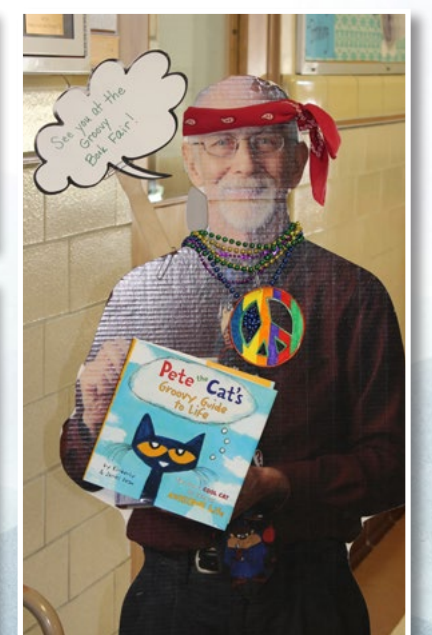

DICK PAVELSKI '67
WITH DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI AWARD

Pacelli Catholic Schools is pleased to announce the recipient of their prestigious Distinguished Alumni Award. Businessman and philanthropist Richard “Dick” Pavelski, a Pacelli Catholic High School graduate of the class of 1967, has been a force in Central Wisconsin agriculture, entrepreneurship, and stewardship for decades.

Most notably, Pavelski is known for his legacy as a 4th generation farmer behind Heartland Farms, Inc., recognized globally for the significant role he’s played in pioneering many of the state-of-the-art best practices in agriculture today. Outside of farming, Pavelski is an active, dedicated community member having served in a variety of capacities on local and national boards, including past roles as Village of Amherst President, US Potato Board and National Potato Council, and Trustee for Pacelli Catholic Schools Foundation, to note a few.

Pavelski’s greatest success, though, is perhaps investing in the futures of his fellow community members. He is without a doubt on the leading edge of job creation and entrepreneurship, having backed over 36 closely held companies and creating over 2,000 new jobs nearly all in Central Wisconsin at places like River Cities Bank, Portage County Bank, Ki Mobility, Wound Zoom, Intevation Foods, Service Cold Storage, and 212 Fitness.

His generosity is second to none, having been quietly very generous to numerous schools and community endeavors including supporting local STEM education, numerous scholarships supporting Central Wisconsin schools, and many community healthcare needs like the breast care center and EMS solutions for Portage County.

Currently, Pavelski has been working on a passion project to bring agricultural education to the broader public, ensuring everyone creates connections to where food comes from and changing the stereotypes of what it means to be a farmer. His project, the Farming for the Future Foundation, will help create education in many schools throughout the country and has plans in the works for a state-of-the-art interactive museum dedicated to agriculture located right here in Central Wisconsin.



Due to the current guidelines surrounding gatherings, Pavelski will be formally recognized in the spring of 2021 with a recognition brunch. He will also serve as the keynote speaker at the Pacelli Catholic High School Class of 2021 graduation ceremony.

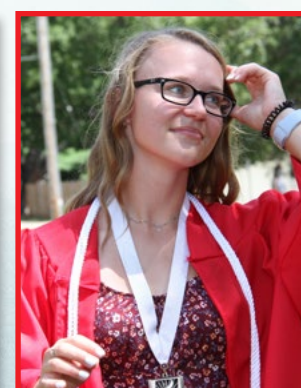
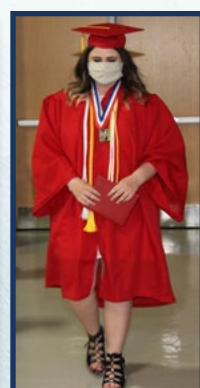
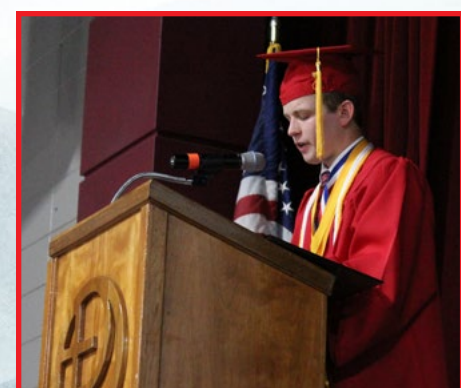
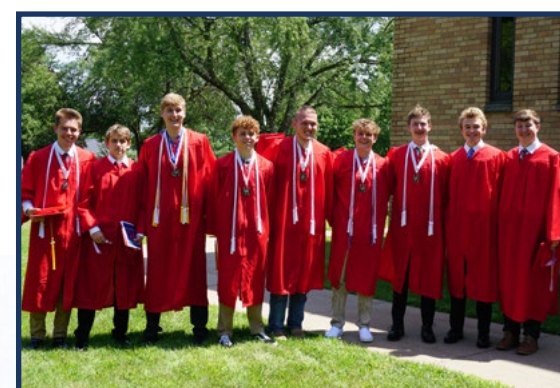
CONGRATULATIONS 2020 GRADUATES

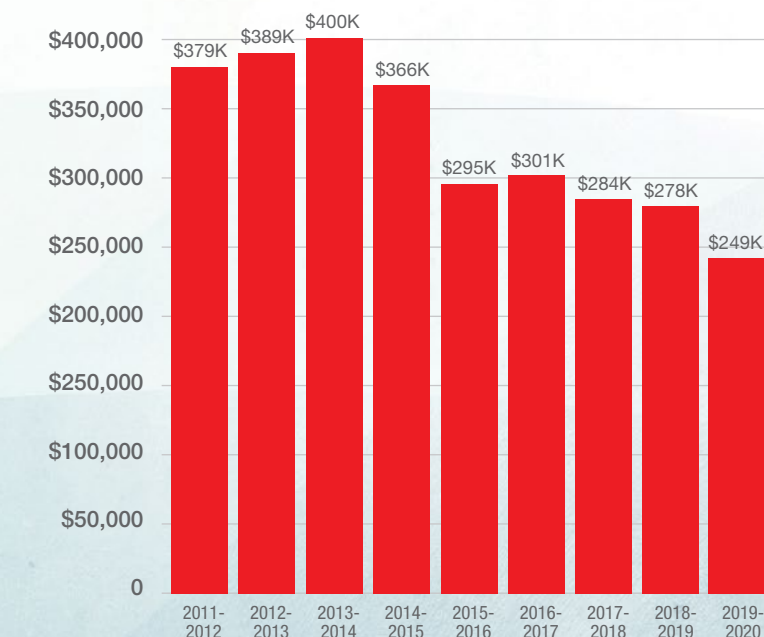
annual operating budget, but it's money you could be earning to offset tuition costs or support your parish.
